



Election Day is November 8 - Do You Have a Plan?

Voting in the midterm elections allows you the opportunity to have a say in your local government. Here's some helpful information from NBC News Washington to help you get your voting game plan together.

D.C. Voting Information:

Early Voting Dates and Locations: Voters can cast their ballots at any voting center, regardless of their residential address. Voting centers are open October 31 to November 6 from 8:30 am. to 7:00 pm and Tuesday, November 8 from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm. [More info](#)

Mail-In Ballot Deadline: All registered voters in D.C. will receive ballots in the mail, but voters who expect to be away from their D.C. residence can request a mail-in ballot. Your voted and mailed ballot must be postmarked or otherwise demonstrated to have been sent on or before Election Day, November 8, and must arrive no later than seven days after Election Day.

Ballot Drop Box Locations in D.C.: You can drop your voted mail-in ballot in any ballot drop box at any time beginning Friday, October 14 until 8:00 pm on Election Day, Tuesday, November 8. [Go here for a full list of drop box locations in D.C.](#)
