On his social media he liked a post of a quote from Golda Meir accompanied with the statement, "Golda Meir was right. [Arabs] hate for Israel is greater than their love for their children."

For the Chief of Family Medicine to like this racist anti-Palestinian and anti-Arab rhetoric generalisation that they "hate Israel" more than they "love their children" contributes to creating a hostile and discriminatory environment, weakening the trust and respect that patients, families and colleagues require in the healthcare context.

To CPSO and OMA: Please treat this email as a formal complaint about the physician. Their behaviour violates the expectations for the professional conduct of physicians on social media.

To UofT: Please treat this email as a formal complaint about the physician as his behaviour creates an unwelcoming environment for clinical fellows, physicians, and patients. What steps will the university be taking to protect Palestinian students and their supporters? What remediation steps will UofT take to help teach Dr. Eisen about professionalism in the workplace?

To North York General Hospital: I request that you release a public statement about your institutions' commitment to providing equitable patient centred healthcare, where patients are free from any sort of discrimination including anti-Palestinian.

I trust that you will handle this issue with the utmost seriousness, ensuring that the medical community remains a space that fosters inclusivity, and trust among patients.
