As you may already know, last year we continued with our after-school tutoring program with North Hunterdon and Voorhees teachers as well as partnered with a virtual tutoring platform through [tutor.com](#). Tutor.com offers free, 24/7 tutoring services to students. This includes tutoring for [100+ subjects](#), including AP®; a drop-off writing review; practice quizzes for math, science, and ELA; and test prep for the SAT and ACT. Both programs are continuing again for this school year!

In regards to the after school tutoring program with our teachers, in the following linked One Stop Tutoring Doc, you will find a list of all our tutors, their subject areas and courses, availability, and their corresponding Google Form. If your student wants to receive help, then they would fill out the teacher's Google Form to request help. While we appreciate parental/guardian support, *you should not be filling out the form*. Once your student signs up for a session, the tutor will get an email notification about the desired meeting time. If a teacher-tutor cannot meet with your student, then the following alternative options are available:
