Body (Give and/or demonstrate necessary information)	Break down what you plan on talking about into manageable sections.  • Literal: Criminology- scientific study of the nature, extent, causes, and control of criminal behavior in both the individual and in society. Classical School- places complete blame on criminal. People have free will and punishment should aim to deter people from committing crime. Positivist School- Crime caused by internal and external factors outside of criminal's control. Utilizes scientific method.
