

## NORWICH BOOSTER CLUB SCHOLARSHIP AWARD APPLICATION

(revised 03/2023)

### Purpose:

Award outstanding Norwich High School graduating Senior's scholarship support for future educational endeavors.

### Awards:

Minimum of 2 scholarships of \$350.00 each. Winners are chosen by the Booster Club Scholarship selection committee. The committee is composed of the Booster Club Board Members and at least two Community Booster Club Members, as needed. Number of Scholarships and amounts may be increased depending on available funds.

### Scholarship Instructions:

If awarded, the scholarship shall be used for the fall semester of the next ensuing school year. (Only a physical condition or disability rendering the recipient unable to attend school would be considered just cause to grant an extension to the following semester. If not used the second semester the scholarship will be forfeited and not given.) The award must be accepted (or extension granted) on or before July 15<sup>th</sup> of the year. In the event the recipient(s) does not accept the award, the Scholarship committee will meet again and an alternate will be chosen.

***Note to Recipients: This Scholarship award will be paid directly to the school of choice or to the student upon presentation of receipt for paid enrollment fee, pending approval of the scholarship committee.***

### Selection Criteria:

1. **Extracurricular Participation:** Senior shall have participated in at least one extra-curricular activity during the school year.  
Examples: Sports, Music, Scholar's Bowl, Cheerleading, Kays, FCA, FFA, NHS, SADD, etc.
2. **Scholastic Achievement:** Senior must have maintained at least a 2.5 cumulative grade point average.
3. **Character:** Senior displays a high degree of character during all school activities.
4. **Moral Values:** Senior displays an adherence to a high moral code.
5. **Leadership Ability:** Senior exerts and shows good leadership qualities in all activities during the school year.
6. **Attitude:** Senior displays a positive attitude to fellow students, school staff, and community.
7. **Volunteerism:** Senior has voluntarily participated with their church, school, or other community volunteer events.

Application preferred to be type written. If handwritten, it must be legible. Illegible forms will not be considered.

Please also list any awards, offices held, leadership achievements, recognitions, jobs held, and volunteer activities during your high school years. Bullet lists or tables may be used. Start with the most recent accomplishments.
