

ORDINANCE ADDRESSING FLOODPLAIN MANAGEMENT PROVISIONS OF THE STATE CONSTRUCTION CODE

Franklin Township, Houghton County, Michigan

Ordinance Number 22

An ordinance to designate an enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the Township of Franklin located in Houghton County, and to designate regulated flood hazard areas under the provisions of the State Construction Code Act, Act No. 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended.

The Township of Franklin ordains:

Section 1. AGENCY DESIGNATION: Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b (6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, the Houghton County Building Inspector is hereby designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the Township of Franklin under Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, State of Michigan. The Houghton County Building Department assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of said Act throughout the corporate limits of the community adopting this ordinance.

Section 2. CODE APPENDIX ENFORCED: Pursuant to the provisions of the Michigan State Construction Code, in accordance with Section 8b (6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, Appendix G of the Michigan Building Code shall be enforced by the enforcing agency within the jurisdiction of the community adopting this ordinance.

Section 3. REPEALS: All ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of the ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Publication: This ordinance shall be effective after legal publication and in accordance with the provisions of the Act governing same.
