Given the nature of our proposed telematch/game obstacle it would be preferable to have an outdoor location.

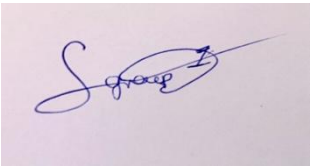
