Programming Updates

• Children's Programs:

 Our school year programs will be mostly complete by June 3 and then we start to transition into summer programming! We met or exceeded our school year program goals (in terms of programs offered and children served) and are fully enrolled for summer camp including an 8 day June mini camp. Planning for August mini-camp is dependent on staff availability.

• Community Engagement.

Our team presented a workshop on our four-year environmental leadership portfolio process to teams of school leaders, teachers, and students from across New England.

The Development Team is thrilled to share that through the HARD work and HEART work of so many, especially Development Manager and Rock to Rock Captain Aurora Coon, we raised more in Rock to Rock 2023 than ever before. Rock to Rock was a community-driven success - with support from students, CGHS high school families, community programs families, teachers, staff, community members, and board members. Collectively, we raised \$35,813 made by donation from 316 people. What's so heartening, and so important to remember, is that 65% of those gifts were less than \$100!
