Use Times New Roman 10pt Italic with single spacing between lines, justified, consists of: purpose (contains objectives of the research), method (delivers data collection of the research), results and impact of the research (refers to collected data as an effort to answer research question). The number of words should be between 150-200 words. Keywords consist of a minimum of 3 words and maximum of 5 words

Keywords: keyword 1; keyword 2; keyword 3.

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Introduction (11pt, Bold)

This template was created to assist writers in preparing their manuscripts. This template is the type of script that editors most expect. To use this template: save (Save As) this file and rename the file to "your name, article title".

The introduction and other subtitles use Times New Roman 11pt bold, small caps with single spacing. Pre-fill using Times New Roman 11pt normal, left and right margins straight.

The whole writing is in the form of paragraphs without numbering, and bulleting. Numbering can be changed first, second, or (1)..., (2)... in paragraph form. The journal manuscript submitted is the result of research with a word count of 6,000 words. A4 format paper size with normal margins (top, bottom, left, right 1 inch or 2.5 cm). Preliminary content reveals the background of the research, related studies that have existed, differences from previous research so that it raises the novelty of the research, the purpose of writing, hopes to be achieved from writing, and scientific benefits from writing.

Research Method (11pt, Bold)

This section describes the research method briefly. Citations use bodynotes. The content of the research method is about 500-1,000 words. The introduction and other subtitles are in Times New Roman 11pt bold. Preface using Times New Roman 11pt normal, left and right margins are straight with single spacing.

Result (11pt, Bold)

The contents of the results and discussion reveal the research findings based on field data obtained by questionnaires, surveys, documents, interviews, observations and other data collection techniques. The research findings are analyzed by interpretation and synthesis with certain theories (can also come from the author's thoughts). In this section there may be numbering. The order of numbering uses the following method: I., A., 1, a.

Citation and citation using the APA Reference Style and using reference management tools (Mendeley/Zotero/Endnote). The basic principles for in-text references are:

(Author's Last Name, Publication Date)

Examples: (Rasyid, 2003); (Azis and Nuryanah, 2019); (Maswarni, et al. 2018)

If no year can be replaced with tt.

Example: (al-Ghazali, tt.)

This section can be supplemented with pictures or tables to provide an explanation. Writing results and discussion using Times New Roman 11pt bold. The images included are an important part of the research results. The color of the image is clear and the size is just right. The title of the image is placed below the image in Times New Roman 11pt. If the image comes from another source, write the source in the center of the image. Sample image:

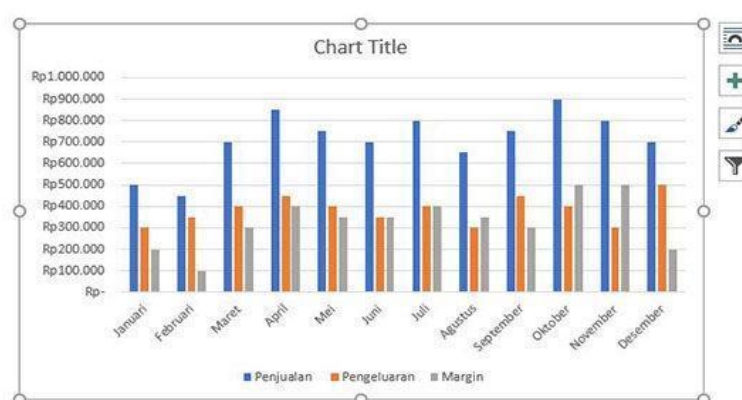


Figure 1. Graph of Indonesia's Per Capita Income

Text and table numbers are placed at the top with Times New Roman 11pt normal, centered. Table lines are simply horizontal lines at the first and end of the table, delete the vertical lines and horizontal lines in the middle of the table. Fill in the table using Times New Roman font, table margins as needed. If the table comes from another source, write the source in the middle of the table.

Conclusion (11pt, Bold)

The conclusion section contains a summary of the answers to the purpose of writing, the limitations of the study, the possibility of applying or developing research and suggestions for further research. Conclusions are written in different sentences from the results and discussion sections, contain 400-500 words, no subtitles, numbering or bulleting. Conclusion using Times New Roman 11pt bold.

Reference (11pt, Bold)

References are arranged alphabetically based on the last name of the cited author. The reference text is Times New Roman 11pt thick, and the reference content uses 10pt size. Reference writing format follows the APA Style Format as below:

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
