

School Meeting Minutes – 2 February 2025

ANNOUNCEMENT: This coming week we will meet on the 1st day of the 12th month (February 9th) as a whole school/Ekklesia (all 4 time zones combined into one meeting) at 7pm Jerusalem time for our 1st of the Month Assembly. We will also have Communion!

*We met on the 24th day of the 11th month in the priest course of Pethahiah. We see that date mentioned in Zech 1:7. We also just entered the Church Cycle of Philadelphia (Rev 3:7-13).

- Zech 1:7 KJV Upon the four and twentieth day of the eleventh month, which is the month Sebat, in the second year of Darius, came the word of the Lord unto Zechariah, the son of Berechiah, the son of Iddo the prophet, saying, 8 I saw by night, and behold a man riding upon a red horse, and he stood among the myrtle trees that were in the bottom; and behind him were there red horses, speckled, and white.
- Zechariah sees the horse riders, and a man among the myrtle trees and behind him a white horse. We are waiting for Christ to appear on His White Horse!
- Zech 1:18 KJV Then lifted I up mine eyes, and saw, and behold four horns. 19 And I said unto the angel that talked with me, What be these? And he answered me, These are the horns which have scattered Judah, Israel, and Jerusalem.
- The horse riders have scattered God's people (Judah, Jerusalem, and Israel). We see the horse riders also in Zech 10, and then again in Zech 12 where we see Jerusalem as a "burdensome stone." The prophecy continues in Zech 14 with Jerusalem being surrounded by armies. That is when His feet will stand on the Mount of Olives.
- That's why we follow closely the events happening in the land of Israel. Israel has to be weak in order for them to be surrounded by armies. They never lost a war since the modern State of Israel was established in 1948. They are currently losing the war and their enemies are rejoicing. With the ceasefire in Gaza and with Hezbollah, the Palestinians are returning by thousands. The same is happening in Southern Lebanon.

*The Scroll Goes Forth!

- Zech 5:1 KJV Then I turned, and lifted up mine eyes, and looked, and behold a flying roll (scroll). 2 And he said unto me, What seest thou? And I answered, I see a flying roll (scroll); the length thereof is twenty cubits, and the breadth thereof ten cubits. 3 Then said he unto me, This is the curse that goeth forth over the face of the whole earth: for every one that stealeth shall be cut off as on this side according to it; and every one that sweareth shall be cut off as on that side according to it. 4 I will bring it forth, saith the Lord of hosts, and it shall enter into the house of the thief, and into the house of him that sweareth falsely by my name: and it shall remain in the midst of his house, and shall consume it with the timber thereof and the stones thereof.
- The scroll relates to the 10 Commandments, and it brings us back to the message from last week about our spiritual condition. We are hoping to be granted the 15th year! We have been shown two conditions that could prohibit us from entering the 15th year: pride and self-righteousness.
- The sickness was given to Hezekiah because of his pride. He became proud after he received victory over the Assyrians. It was by the hand of the angel of the Lord that the camp of the Assyrians was destroyed.
- 2 Kings 19:35 KJV And it came to pass that night, that the angel of the Lord went out, and smote in the camp of the Assyrians an hundred fourscore and five thousand: and when they arose early in the morning, behold, they were all dead corpses. 36 So Sennacherib king of Assyria departed.
- 2 Chron 32:22 KJV Thus the Lord saved Hezekiah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem from the hand of Sennacherib the king of Assyria, and from the hand of all other, and guided them on every side.
- 2 Chron 32:23 KJV And many brought gifts unto the Lord to Jerusalem, and presents to Hezekiah king of Judah: so that he was magnified in the sight of all nations from thenceforth.
- 2 Chron 32:25 KJV But Hezekiah **rendered not** again according to the benefit done unto him; for his heart was lifted up...26 Notwithstanding Hezekiah humbled himself for the pride of his heart.
- Job was our other example we saw few weeks ago. He was a righteous man of his day, perfect and upright (Job 1:1). The problem was that he knew he was righteous, and this made him self-righteous. He gave credit to himself and not to YHWH for all of his righteous deeds.
- Job 32:1 KJV So these three men ceased to answer Job, because he was righteous in his own eyes.

- Job 35:1 KJV Elihu spake moreover, and said, 2 Thinkest thou this to be right, that thou saidst, My righteousness is more than God's?
- We hope as a school that all of us will take heed and repent!

*It's been 3 years since we first assembled on zoom as a school! May to the Most High be all the glory for gathering us from the 4 corners of the world for such a time as this. We continue to watch, study and worship together! The King is coming soon!

*Below is a summary of visions received during our heavenly worship time with the psaltery:

- Saw a fountain with flowing water surrounded by a wrought iron fence. In the next scene, she saw herself walking up the 10 steps into the Holy Place. Before she reached the top, she saw a thick dark cloud billowing out of the Holy of Holies and filling the Temple.
- Saw the East Gate leading to the Song Chamber.
- She saw herself hiking up a mountain. She felt like she had no strength to continue to climb. She sat down on a large rock to rest. Then Christ appeared and offered her His help. To demonstrate the concept, a door appeared before each child and they were asked to go through the door not knowing what they would find behind it. Each child went one by one through the door. Then her turn came. She knocked on the door and the door opened. She went through it and saw Christ sitting on the Throne. It was just Christ and her alone. She was no longer a child but a grown woman. She sat at His feet and started to anoint His feet with oil. Then, as Leeland started to play an instrumental part, the scene changed and she saw herself waltzing with the King around a royal looking room with long hangings on the walls.
- Saw scenes depicted in Psalm 23: green pastures, still waters and a table set.
- Saw vast waters.
