- By law we can have referendums for 8 years but can only ask to renew them on odd years, so we need to do it NOW because we can't have a gap year.
 - We want to maintain what we have. We are not asking for anything additional
 - Necessary to keep small class sizes
 - What has happened when the referendum has not passed?
 - Put 42 kids in 6th grade math class
 - PE classes over 60 kids in middle school
