## Update - 29th of October 2024



A display board has also been created in The Brae to highlight the ways in which children's rights are being celebrated and discussed there.




Across the school, we have launched an 'Article of the Month'. Each month, a different right will be highlighted as the focus article and this will be shared and discussed in Home Rooms and at our assemblies. **Article 12** was Article of the Month for October: **Respect for the Views of the Child**.



At Rosehill, all children have the right to express their views, feelings and wishes. We do this in many ways by:

- using pupil voice daily in our classrooms, linking learning where possible to pupils' interests
- using self and peer assessment in lessons
- giving pupils regular opportunities to 'formally' express their views and feelings through our Home Rooms
- inviting pupils to participate in groups, such as the Rights Respecting School committee
- using tools, strategies, and specialist equipment, such as communication aids, to allow all pupils to have a voice
- gathering pupil voice for Child Planning Meetings, and where appropriate, inviting children to participate and share their views directly at these meetings

Our Article of the Month for November is **Article 19 - Protection from Violence**, **Abuse and Neglect**. This will link closely with Anti-Bullying Week and UK Disability History Week.
