Breakout Session Day I

“Outreach” Working Group

We discussed what the working group has done to this point (provide a forum for discussion and presentation by groups working on languages and scripts other than Greco-Roman). We then considered how this working group might function moving forward, and how it would interact with the other Epigraphy.info working groups. (It was noted that many groups and scholars working on non-Greco-Roman languages and scripts would naturally be interested in areas covered by existing working groups, e.g. Ontology or Vocabulary.) One suggestion was that the working group might take as its goal the connection of Greco-Roman epigraphists and non-Greco-Roman epigraphists, both by bringing non-Greco-Roman epigraphists into Epigraphy.info and by helping Greco-Roman epigraphists connect to relevant non-Greco-Roman epigraphists outside of Epigraphy.info. This goal might be served both by synchronous efforts like the seminar series run previously by the working group and by asynchronous efforts to create a broader, connected network of epigraphists.

VincentR: To back Francisca's idea, we should perhaps consider building a form to be sent to all the partners listed on epigraphy.info website, so that essential information about each project could be also provided (technology, standards used, tools being used or developed, ???).

Each project would have a record and an index could help people to find what they need (see for instance the Biblissima Toolbox: <https://baobab.biblissima.fr/>).

We probably should use the TaDirah (<https://tadirah.info/>) vocabularies (<https://vocabs.dariah.eu/tadirah/en/>), with extra things specific to epigraphy.
