QUESTION: What are the good things you can think of about raising pigs? (10 min)

Income

- earn money
- if it's big enough we can sell it
- we only invest 1500 bhat but can get more money by selling it
- sell a pig and buy two more
- can start a new business or buy a new pig
- pigs grow & make baby pigs, can sell and earn more income
- baby pigs make more income
- they can produce more piglets and sell
- can reproduce them
- start business
- baby pigs bring money
- with many pigs we have more money
- guarantee for living/health
- make more money
- save money
- it will be easier to get income
- pig can be sold when money is needed
- get more money
- can save money
- money problem can be solved
- can solve the difficulties
- we can eat the pig or sell the pig

Use of profits

can spend income where we want to spend

School

- with money we can give to monks, live better, pay for children's school
- money for children's education
- can earn money for students
- can support the children and send to school
- can prepare the future of our children
- if there are more pigs we can get money to send our children to school
- can contribute extra money to schooling
- capable of providing money for children

<u>Temple</u>

• my son can become a little monk

Household

- extra money can be spent on better health, food, clothes, house
- can make repairs to the house
- can buy better food

Burma

- support needs of family in Burma
- can buy land in burma
- can build a house in burma

Other benefits

- good for family
- help elders
- help orphans
- help neighbors
- pigs cannot be harmful to others' homes if we take care of the pigs
- kids love pigs if there is no friend, can play with or be friend with pig

QUESTION: What are the challenges in raising pigs? (10 min)

Pigs' health

- the pigs need to take medicine
- In bad weather the pigs get ill, sometimes die
- every day need to take care of pigs health
- sometimes the pigs get sick
- be careful of pigs' health in the hot season
- we need to take care of their health
- it can affect our health
- if they get sick it is difficult to take them to the clinic
- we always need to check them
- we will lose if they die
- there is no vet
- we need to buy some medicine for their health
- can't afford medicine for them
- need people to treat sickness

- health care
- some pigs died because of the fire
- after the fire some people couldn't care for their pigs
- pigs have to take medicine
- they need body exercise, have to walk sometimes

Effects on human health

- it can be harmful for people to live very near the pigs' house
- have to wash your hands after holding the pig
- smell is bad for people's health
- smell bad
- bad smell
- bad smell
- harmful for some people
- some people feel sick because of pigs
- affect health negatively
- people can't sleep from the noise
- noisy
- we lose our sleep
- don't get enough sleep

Feeding

- feed the pigs 3 times/day
- need to check the pig's food before feeding to check for bad food
- sometimes need to buy food for pigs
- cook pigs' food and be clean
- mix pigs' food with other vegetables
- put fish in the food to make them want to eat
- rice must be cooked to feed them
- at night people find food from the prison car
- if we don't find food they have to buy
- buying food costs money
- looking for pigs' food
- if we can't buy from market need to cook rice from home
- be careful choosing food don't feed them sticky rice
- we need to feed them on time and every day
- there are difficulties to feed them
- we need to hire a person to carry food to the pigs
- if we cannot get food from outside we need to share our food with them
- finding foods
- waking up early to find food for pigs
- we have to compete for food
- can't buy them enough food

- need more money for food
- food shortages
- difficulties getting food from the dump

Space/environment issues

- need space for them
- should build a house for the pigs
- space problem when flood happens
- a good house for the pigs is needed
- have to spend money on pig pens
- if many pigs together can be difficult
- during the fire people had to run with their pigs to escape

Cleanliness

- need to clean the pigs house
- give water and clean their bodies
- we need to clean them
- we need to clean their house daily
- have to bathe them
- have to clean the pigs' space
- take care to bathe them
- water needed
- have to care and clean pigs' bodies
- need water to clean their bodies

Time requirements

- needs a lot of time
- it takes time to care for the pigs
- free time now spent on pigs
- it's a lot to take care of house and pigs
- need more time to take care
- have to look for them when they go out
- pigs are demanding
- time burden
- difficulties with looking for the pigs
- have to give time for their care

- more time to clean the pig pen
- we need to look after the pigs
- if the pig is sick I can't work my job
- give more time for pig than for job
- if the pigs walk freely, owner has to find it

Reproduction issues

- to have babies need to find a male pig
- if the pig wants to be pregnant they run away, jump
- if the pig has babies, need to care for the babies
- need to clean extra for the little pigs
- watch that piglets aren't bitten by other animals
- if 2 pigs are pregnant put one in house
- When pigs are born is a busy time need to be careful they don't die
- hard finding a male pig to impregnate
- be careful that pregnant pigs don't miscarry
- newborn pigs need milk 5 times in the night
- sometimes people have to feed the babies milk
- keep newborn pigs in a basket so they won't die
- be careful that newborns don't get stuck under the mother's body
- give the pigs more showers when near newborns
- they have to pay 500 bhat for male pigs to impregnate
- there are few male pigs at the dump
- hard to find male pig
- difficulty finding a male pig for mating

Social challenges

- some of us are inexperienced
- social problems with neighbors
- competition for food from the dump
- people have problem with the nearby field owner
- conflict with landowner
- sometimes the dogs bite the pigs
- dogs bite the pigs
- when pigs fear they become difficult

QUESTION: What can you do to make sure your pig lives healthy without burdening your own family's health? (15 min)

Housing

- Pig's houses should be built a little far from people's homes
- Keep pigs away from people
- put space between house and pig pen

- build the pigs house a little far from human beings
- keep distance between pigs and house
- put pigs together in a pen to use less space
- make a pen for the pigs
- make the pen safe
- make a roof for the pig pen
- pig's house should have a roof
- build a tall house for the pigs because of water/floods
- put the pigs near the house but not under
- rebuild broken pens
- build a good pen away from people
- build pens a little far from house
- don't live with pigs in the same house

Healthcare

- health care for the pig
- Pig medicine must be ready
- treat with medicine at the beginning of a pig's sickness
- Be more careful in summer
- health care
- go to clinic when pig gets sick
- Take care that the pig doesn't get injured
- be aware that pigs can die
- some pigs are coughing
- keep pigs safe
- give iodine (salt)
- give medicines to the pigs when they get sick
- check the health of the pig once a week
- need a blanket and fire during the very cold season
- use mosquito killer (mosquito fire stick)
- use a mosquito net for the pig
- protect it from mosquitoes
- protect them from mosquitoes
- set fire to not get bit by mosquitoes
- prevent bites from dogs and mosquitoes
- take care of our own health

Feeding

- feed regularly
- provide fresh food
- put the food plate higher than the floor so pig's waste doesn't enter
- feed pigs regularly so they don't scream and keep people awake
- boil the pigs food

- provide nutritious foods
- · don't fight with each other for pigs' food, just buy it
- provide food on time
- provide nutritious foods
- only provide fresh food to pig
- feed them 3x per day

- take care to give nutritious food
- sometimes put some meat in the food
- Fresh food
- give fresh food
- provide enough clean and nutritious food
- make food for baby pigs
- feed them vegetables to become fat
- eat good and nutritious food
- feed them 3x per day

Cleanliness

- Clean the pig's house 3 times every day
- clean the pig's food plate
- clean the floor of the pen
- be careful not to wait too long before washing
- clean pig pen twice daily
- make sure the waste can flow out easily
- after feeding/washing the pig wash hands with soap
- shower the pigs at least once per week
- wash hands after cleaning the pigs
- clean the pig's house daily
- clean the pigs every day
- clean the pigs house every day
- use gloves and mask when you clean pigs' waste
- clean pig's house
- pay attention to personal hygiene
- clean up pig's waste every day
- after feeding bathe the pigs
- clean the pen daily
- give a shower
- fresh water for both pigs and people
- clean the pigs
- wash hands after taking care of pigs
- terrible smell
- clean the pens regularly

- clean yourself after feeding pigs
- give showers to pigs when hot
- bathe the pigs
- keep pens and food plates clean
- stay away from the bad smell
- keep ourself clean after feeding the pigs
- take shower two times a day after feeding pigs
- give shower to the pig
- clean pens regularly
- divide the food and sleep place
- give shower before feeding
- clean the pigs space every week

Other tips/issues

- Learn about pig problems from a more experienced person
- Check that children don't touch and get affected by pigs' sickness
- take turns cooking food so that one can rest
- don't eat meat from sick pigs
- give some clothes to the pig when it's cold
- let the pig walk freely sometimes and keep in pen sometimes
- don't give water when the sun is too hot
- you can work but also take care of the pigs

QUESTION: What issues affect how much money you make raising pigs? (15 min)

Business planning

- First one pig sells, then buy another 2 pigs
- buy another pig after selling
- When a pig is sold, use some money to buy another
- buy a new pig from profit
- Raise more pigs
- female pigs grow faster than males (and produce babies too)
- reproduce pigs

Sales process

- When selling the pigs, find 3 or 4 buyers
- Inquire about the correct price before selling
- do not sell to buyers that offer low prices
- Don't sell on credit
- sell to a cash buyer
- can hope for 3500 bhat profit
- · we might get paid less than expected

- after raising for 1 year we can get a good price
- Sell them when nobody else is selling their pigs
- only sell to someone who offers a good price
- find the right time to get a good price
- care about the price
- only sell pigs with the price you want
- sell the pig to others not living at the dump
- get more money when it is (temple) donation time
- some people don't give a good price
- ignorant of how much pigs are worth
- be knowledgeable about up to date pig price
- got 4800 bhat expected 5000
- sold 2 big pigs got 11,000 bhat, bought 7 piglets back
- sold 1 pig bought 2 pigs
- after sell 1 pig bought 3 pigs back and bought something for house
- be patient to wait for good price
- get a good price in rainy season
- sell the pig to one who gives more money
- if we sell the pigs that we didn't kill we will get more money

Feeding

- to get good price, feed pig 3x per day
- feed nutritious food
- feed regularly with enough food
- feed the pigs so they become fat
- feed the pigs more vegetables so they have better health
- Feed them well and at specific times
- when we look for food ourselves instead of buying, we can reduce expenses
- feed them regularly and at exact times
- provide enough food
- provide nutritious food
- feed it the food on time
- nutritious food so they are healthy
- find food in the dump
- give enough food to the pig
- sometimes give food from the dump, sometimes cook
- give more food to eat so pig becomes bigger

Cleanliness

- 1st pig was sold because of living condition
- need more space for pigs
- big house is needed to be cleaner
- help the pig stay clean

Pigs' health

- be careful of the pig's health
- if the pigs are healthy a good price can be got
- medicines are needed for their health
- more care is needed when the weather is too hot or too cold
- care for their health, since we cannot get a good price if they are sick
- health care for pigs
- set fires to keep away mosquitoes
- give them vitamins to grow
- underweight
- not healthy
- give vitamins for pig growth
- pig can get sick in hot weather
- give shower to the pig 3x per day when it's hot

Motivations

- spend profit on children
- donate profit to monks
- save for school, healthcare, emergency case
- save money
- use for general usages
- can donate (to temple/monks) from savings
- use money from pigs to send kids to school, also to buy another pig & donate to temple

QUESTION: What will make it comfortable for another 120 pigs to live here? (15 min)

Space & housing

- build larger houses for the pigs
- if there are many pigs the pigs house should be extended
- should put pigs' houses a little far from people houses
- people and pigs should live separately
- find some space for the pigs
- have enough and clean space for the pigs
- make more spaces for pigs
- pigs need a clean place and food
- put pigs house in good place

Feeding

- spend more time to find pig food
- feed the pigs vegetables
- have enough food
- nutritious food

- don't need to buy food for the pigs only sometimes
- if there is no food at the dump, we can buy it
- need enough food supply
- buy food for them if food is not enough

Healthcare

- take good care of the pigs
- keep them healthy
- pig medicine should be ready
- in hot weather pigs should be cleaned daily
- give a shower daily so the environment isn't made dirty
- be careful of communicable diseases
- clean up pig's space regularly
- take care of health
- clean the pen every day
- if there is a fire on the dump, move the pigs to a place far from the fire
- clean the pigs' house so the smell doesn't harm people
- be clean
- because pigs live at the dump, need to clean 3x per day
- take care of their health
- buy medicines for the pigs

Facing the challenges

- one more pig is better
- if we have enough money from pigs we can leave the dump
- if we raise pigs house by house it will be ok
- better to raise pigs separately
- pigs can't live all together
- it can be comfortable if we take good care
- take responsibility
- look after & take care not to give troubles to others
- our neighbors can also get money
- by being careful it can be more productive
- let them go out twice a week so don't have to look for them daily
- many pigs might bring many problems but we will face them
