Program Description

The Associate in Sports Management program with a Specialization in Faith-Based Youth Sports and Development prepares students to lead and mentor young athletes through sports programs grounded in biblical values. This program emphasizes physical development, leadership, teamwork, and character formation through faith-centered coaching and community-based sports initiatives.

Students will explore sports administration, event planning, athletic training, and youth development while learning how to use sports as a tool for discipleship, outreach, and holistic well-being.

Graduates may serve in youth sports ministries, athletic outreach programs, recreation departments, or pursue further study in kinesiology, ministry, or education.
