- 1. Accessibility: <u>The DOJ Title II</u> rule prompted emails to faculty members to improve course accessibility scores. The deadline they have shared for this to be completed is April 2026.

- 2. Course design: On March 26th, the provost's office announced the Simple Syllabus to all faculty via email and Canvas notifications.
 - Simple Syllabus is a centralized, template-driven platform that enables instructors to personalize and publish interactive class syllabi quickly.
 - Instructors are required to complete their syllabi four weeks before the course begins.

- b. Faculty will be able to request their courses by **November**. Please encourage them to keep the <u>UH course request policy</u> in mind.
- c. The Office 365 landing page has been updated to display the **Microsoft 365 CoPilot homepage**. Faculty can now either navigate to the "apps" section to access their office
 365 apps or bookmark and directly navigate to the list of apps.
