Special Event Dress Code for Students and Guests

Special events include: banquets, concerts, etc. In addition to EBISD's Student Dress Code, please adhere to the following guidelines.

These events should be fun and memorable, but we also want everyone to be comfortable, safe, and show BRAHMA PRIDE. With modesty and safety in mind, **the following dress code guidelines will be enforced at the East Bernard High School events**. As you begin shopping for your special occasion attire, please keep these guidelines in mind.

Girls Dress Code:

- Dresses must be appropriately fitting and modest.
 - Excessive cleavage is not allowed.
 - Midriffs may not be exposed. This includes both the front and sides of the dress.
 - Dress length and slit must not exceed mid-thigh (fingertip length).
 - Spaghetti straps are allowed provided they follow the previous rules. MELISSA--

- Pantsuits or rompers may be worn, but must follow the guidelines, for skirt length
Dresses and pantsuits should be appropriately fitting and modest
Necklines should be conservative in nature; excessive cleavage is not allowed
Dress length and slit must not exceed fingertip length
Midriffs may not be exposed, this includes both the front and sides
Jeans may be worn, but may not have holes or fraying, including the hem.

Boys Dress Code (for EBHS students and guests) :

- Jeans may be worn; however, they need to be pressed or starched. Jeans should have no holes or fraying, including the hem.
- Pants should fit properly on the hip and not sag below the waistline.
- Shirts must be buttoned up to the second button.
- Dress shoes or dress boots only.
