

## **LOCAL HANCOCK SCHOLARSHIPS**

The following is a list of local scholarships that are available to you. Read the requirements carefully and apply for the ones that fit your future plans. The only competition for these scholarships is your graduating class.

### **Star Bank - 1 X \$750**

Stock Market game winner- All seniors are eligible, no application needed.

### **Owls Hoot Scholarship - \$500**

- 1) GPA of 3.0 or above.
- 2) Attending a one or two year technical college, community college, or four year college
- 3) Active member of the Hancock school student body.
- 4) Active within the community.

### **Hancock Education Association Scholarship -2 X \$250**

- 1) GPA of 3.0 or above.
- 2) Involved in extracurricular activities.
- 3) Preference for those attending a four year college or university
- 4) Of good moral character.

### **Old Castle Scholarship - 2 X \$500**

- 1) GPA of 3.0 or above.
- 2) Preference to those attending a four year college or university.
- 3) Preference given to students majoring in business or engineering.

### **Benn Scholarship - \$250**

- 1) GPA of 3.0 or above.
- 2) Preference for those attending a four year college or university.
- 3) Must have been active in the music program at HHS.
- 4) Must be active in community activities.
- 5) Must have involvement in school activities.
- 6) Or musical talent and training.

### **Carole Johnson Honorary Scholarship - \$300**

- 1) GPA of 3.0 or above.
- 2) Attending a one or two year technical college, community college, or four year college
- 3) Active member of the student body.
- 4) Positive role model for underclassmen.
- 5) Respectful of school personnel, education and property.
- 6) Active part of the community.
- 7) Be a Hancock School District Student.

**Bremer Community Service Award - \$250**

- 1) GPA of 3.0 or above.
- 2) Attending a one or two year technical college, community college, or four year college.
- 3) Cannot be the son or daughter of an employee of Bremer Bank or a relative of an employee of this bank.
- 4) Must be involved in community and school service.
- 5) Leadership qualities.

**Stevens Community Medical Center - 2 X \$300**

- 1) Parents or student work at a Hancock business

**Please print the scholarship application**

Scholarship Committee - either through school officials, the company or individual sponsoring the scholarship.

Applications must be typed, double-spaced and complete. If not, you will be asked to redo it or your chance of getting a scholarship decreases.

Application must be complete or it will be ineligible.

**AFTER RECEIVING A LOCAL SCHOLARSHIP:**

You must send a “thank you” if you received a scholarship.

You must give your FALL semester transcript of your FRESHMAN year to Mrs. Cronen BEFORE you receive your award indicating that you have taken and passed a FULL LOAD (12 credits) and a GPA of at least 3.0, or unless stated differently on scholarship requirements.

\*\*If you do not meet the requirements for the fall semester, you need to submit your spring semester grade for approval.

After receiving your transcript following your freshman fall or spring semester, your scholarship check will be made out to the institution you are attending.

**You have ONE year to claim your scholarship or it is NULL and VOID!!**
