PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT

Between the parties:

WEST UNIVERSITY OF TIMISOARA, headquartered in Timișoara, Vasile Pârvan blvd. no. 4, Timiș county, fiscal code 4250670, legally represented by Rector Prof. univ. dr. Marilen Gabriel PIRTEA, confirmed by Order of the Minister of Education no. 3697/01.02.2024, hereinafter referred to as UVT,
and

The parties agree to conclude this Partnership Agreement for the development of a sustainable framework for collaboration between the university and the economic and social environment in order to establish the conditions under which they will collaborate to promote mutual interests, as follows:

Art.1 Agreement participation

By signing this Partnership Agreement, the parties express their openness to designing and implementing joint actions that will address:

- a) students;
- b) teachers;
- c) faculty graduates, members of the alumni community (where applicable);
- d) representatives from the partner organization.

Art.2 Subject of the Agreement

The object of this partnership is the collaboration between the two partners in the following actions:

- a) Establishing a permanent dialogue between the company and the university;
- b) Preparing students for better insertion into the labor market by facilitating access to practice stages and practical training, as well as informing them about the partner's job offers;
- c) Establishing the operational framework that allows students of the Faculty of Informatics at UVT to complete practice stages at the partner's location or online;
- d) Identifying ways of cooperation to develop scientific research and technology transfer;
- e) Organizing in partnership programs for university students with the aim of informing, educating and supporting the professional training process (trainings, workshops, seminars, developing case studies, etc.);

- f) Organization, with logistical support from UVT, of events at the initiative of the partner or the university, such as: round tables on various topics of interest, annual company presentations in which students can participate, conferences, debates, etc.
- g) Support provided for strengthening the alumni community through participation in events, popularization of the alumni platform, identification of new alumni members, etc.

Art. 3 Principles of good practice of the partnership agreement

- (1) The parties must consult regularly and keep each other informed on all aspects of the progress of the projects.
- (2) All partners must implement activities in compliance with the highest professional and ethical standards.

Art. 4 Duration of the agreement

- (1) The duration of this agreement is 5 years, term which begins to run from the date of signing this document.
- (2) In the absence of written notification sent by one of the parties, at least 15 days before the expiration of the validity period of this agreement, it will be automatically extended for another year, unless one of the parties notifies the other in writing of its intention not to extend the partnership agreement.

Art. 5 Obligations of partners

- (1) The obligations of the partner, the Faculty of Informatics within UVT, are the following:
 - a) To ensure and respect the partner's visual identity;
 - b) To inform through specific means about cooperation with(brochures presenting specializations, periodic newsletter, etc.);
 - c) To inform students and partnersthe homework for the practice stages, in accordance with the practice stages curriculum specific to the specialization.
 - d) To promote joint events organized together withon official promotion channels (institution's website, Facebook page, etc.);
 - e) To provide, within the limits of available spaces, the logistics necessary to organize various events organized in partnership.
- (2) Partner obligationsare the following:
 - a) To collaborate and support the development of joint activities by providing expertise and resources for the activities in which it is involved (practicing experts, practice tutors, guest speakers, mentors, etc.);
 - b) To analyze the possibility of supporting students' activities in carrying out scientific/disciplinary projects through designated specialists, together with academic staff;
 - c) To transmit information of interest to the intended target group (students, teachers, UVT employees) to be disseminated on UVT promotion channels;
 - d) To ensure adequate logistics for the development of the collaboration (where applicable).

Art. 6 Liability of the parties

- (1) Each party is responsible for the proper execution of the obligations assumed under this Agreement.
- (2) The Parties are individually responsible for respecting copyright and related rights in achieving the purpose of this Agreement.

Art. 7 Confidentiality

- (1) The parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of information received during the performance of the activities that are the subject of this partnership agreement, except for information that is public, according to the law.
- (2) Each Party shall adopt its own measures to prevent the unauthorized use or disclosure of the information referred to in paragraph (1).
- (3) The information referred to in paragraph (1) may only be used for the purpose of fulfilling the obligations referred to in this partnership agreement.

Art. 8 Processing of personal data

The parties undertake to process personal data obtained by virtue of the execution of this partnership agreement in compliance with the principles set out in *Regulation (EU) 2016/679 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation)*. Each Party undertakes to implement reasonable physical, technical and administrative security measures to prevent incidents such as loss, misuse, unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration or destruction of personal data. In the event of a data processing incident, each Party must notify the other within 24 hours.

Art. 9 Final provisions

- (1) This agreement has the character of a framework document and covers the entire activity to achieve the agreed common objectives. In order to carry out other actions derived from the framework objectives, the parties will conclude additional acts to this agreement in which they will specifically establish the responsibilities of each of them and the limits of the activities concerned.
- (2) At the level of the West University of Timișoara, this partnership agreement and any subsequent steps arising from its execution are subject to approval (signature) by the Vice-Rector responsible for institutional partnerships, European project management and entrepreneurship - Prof. Dr. Flavia Mirela Barna.
- (3) All communications between the parties regarding the signing and execution of this agreement will be made in writing, to the following correspondence addresses:
