GHS Summer School Credit Recovery:

July 7th-28th

\$50 for the first class, \$25 for all additional courses (Cash or Bank Check)

Students who have attained a final grade of 50 or higher in a math, science, ELA, history, and/or health course can enroll in Credit Recovery and attempt specifically designed Edmentum Plato credit recovery courses.

Classes will meet Monday through Friday **in person** in the GHS Cafeteria from July 7th-July 28th.

-One Course Students: 7:30am-10:00am

-Two Course Students: 7:30am-12:30pm

- Students who are “absent” more than three (3) times from July 7 through the completion of their course(s) will no longer be eligible for credit. Tardiness will count as one of the three allowable absences.
- Students that successfully finish the coursework early will be released from the program with the appropriate credit issued.
- Students can initially attempt up to 2 courses and possibly more if time allows.
- Courses are only offered to Gloucester High School students.

FEE: \$50 for the first course, and \$25 for all additional courses (Cash or Bank Check)

Attendance, payment, and successful completion of course work result in credit.

GHS Summer School Semesters:

July 7 - August 7

\$50 for the first class, \$25 for all additional courses (Cash or Bank Check)

Students who have attained a final grade of 49 or lower in a math, science, ELA, history, and/or health course can enroll in Summer School Semesters and attempt specifically designed Edmentum Plato semester based courses.

Classes will meet Monday through Friday **in person** in the GHS Cafeteria from July 7th-August 7th.

- Students who are “absent” more than three (3) times from July 7 through the completion of their course(s) will no longer be eligible for credit. Tardiness will count as one of the three allowable absences.
- Students that successfully finish the coursework early will be released from the program with the appropriate credit issued.
- Courses are only offered to Gloucester High School students.

FEE: \$50 for the first course, and \$25 for all additional courses (Cash or Bank Check)

Attendance, payment, and successful completion of course work result in credit.

Algebra 1 Specific: If below 60% for a Final Grade in Algebra 1, students will take the CP2 Final Exam at the completion of the Algebra 1 Plato curriculum to be eligible to move on to Geometry in the fall with a score of 65%.
