An Amish Quilting Bee Square

Part of the Read and Crochet Along (RCAL)

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Welcome to the **Read and Crochet Along (RCAL)**. If you love reading and crochet, this CAL is for you! Each square is inspired by one of my books and has an accompanying tutorial.

The pattern is customizable. Use any size yarn, type of yarn, and any size hook. You can make a small, medium, or large square by subtracting or adding rounds/using a smaller or larger hook. You can also reverse the order of the colors or use different ones. It's up to you! It's also a great scrap yarn project.

Materials used for the pictured square are below.

- Red Heart Super Saver Yarn in **Turqua, Minty, Buff, Burgundy**
- US **H** Hook (or hook recommended for yarn or size used for previous squares)
- Scissors
- Yarn needle to weave in ends
- Measuring tape or ruler

Square measures approximately 5 in. x 5 in. Gauge not necessary for this project.

Abbreviations:

RS: right side facing	dc: double crochet.	FO: fasten off
WS: wrong side facing	st(s): stitch(es)	sp: space
ch: chain	SM: stitch marker	
hdc: half double crochet	slst: slip stitch	

Notes: Ch1 does not count as a stitch. You may wish to mark the first st with a SM for clarity.

Pattern:

With Minty, ch 5, slst join to make a ring, do not pull tight- leave a hole, ch 1.

Round 1:

(RS) Working all sts into the ring (hdc 3, ch 3) x4, slst join into top of first hdc, ch1.

Round 2:

(hdc 3, hdc 2 in sp, ch 3, hdc 2 in same sp) x4, slst join into top of first hdc and FO.

Round 3:

With Buff, attach in any corner sp, ch 4, dc across next 7 sts, dc 2 in sp, ch 3, dc 2 in same sp, dc across next 7 sts, ch 3, slst into sp and FO. Turn.

Round 4:

(WS) Attach Burgundy to ch 3 sp, ch 4, dc across next 9 sts, dc 2 in sp, ch 3, dc 2 in same sp, dc across next 9 sts, ch 3, slst into sp and FO. Turn.

Round 5:

(RS) Attach Turqua to Minty ch 3 space, dc 2 sts into sp, ch 3, dc 2 into same sp, dc across next 7 sts, dc 2 in Minty ch 3 sp, dc 2 in Buff ch 3 sp. (corner 1, side 1)

dc 2 in Burgundy ch 3 sp, ch 3, dc 2 in same sp, dc across next 11 sts. (corner 2, side 2)

dc 2 in sp, ch3, dc 2 in same sp, dc across next 11 sts. (corner 3, side 3)

dc 2 in sp, ch 3, dc 2 in same sp, dc 2 in Buff ch 3 sp, dc 2 in Minty ch 3 sp, dc across next 7 sts, slst join into top of first dc and FO. (corner 4, side 4)

Tighten starting ring as needed for square to lie flat. Weave in any remaining ends! Block if you wish.
