Resolution to Review Pedestrian Crosswalks and Signal Systems on

Hampton Drive

WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 04, 2025

Whereas Hampton Drive is a heavily used pedestrian route for Butler University students traveling between residence halls, academic buildings, and Greek housing, and

Whereas students have expressed concern regarding the safety of current pedestrian crossings and the visibility and functionality of crosswalk lights and button systems, and

Whereas the addition of new crosswalk infrastructure or upgrades to existing crosswalks may significantly improve pedestrian safety, and

Whereas the Student Government Association is committed to advocating for student safety and well-being across campus, let it be

Resolved that the Student Senate formally encourages Executive Director of Finance and Facilities Douglas Baldino to review all pedestrian crosswalks along Hampton Drive, including the functionality and visibility of crosswalk lights and pedestrian button systems,

Resolved further that the Student Senate recommends that the Executive Director of Finance and Facilities evaluate the functionality and safety of the pedestrian crosswalk in front of Residential College and Sigma Chi,

Resolved further that the Student Senate encourages a review of the existing crossing light at Pi Beta Phi and B-permit parking to ensure adequate pedestrian protection and visibility.
