



San Raymundo, Guatemala

December 28th-January 2nd

TRIP DETAILS:

- When:** Sunday, December 28th - Friday, January 2nd
- Who:** Family Ministry Adult Volunteers & High School Students that attend RP
- Cost:** \$TBD (Incl: all travel, food, lodging, excursion, and travel insurance)
- Capacity:** 25 total (First come, first serve basis)

WHAT WE WILL DO:

- Build a House in 3 days
- Dedication service for the family
- Serve at a local school
- Excursion day (did volcano last year. Will do the historic site of Antigua or Mayan ruins this year.)

ABOUT SAN RAYMUNDO:

- Traditional Mayan spirituality exists, but Roman Catholicism is the main religion, followed closely by Evangelical Christianity.
- Community driven, families live together
- Poor. People we built for last year made about \$52/week.
- But rich. One thing we walked away w/ last year is how rich they are because they have margin, community, shared experiences, and contentment.

FUNDRAISING:

- Each person will create a Managed Missions profile. A link to this profile will be sent to your friends and family for them to donate money to your trip.
- Will setup a way for church members to give online from the RP website in 2025.

PASSPORT:

-Passport Book Required (need to do this ASAP. Do not wait to get a passport until next year. Sometimes there are delays.)

- For those that already have their passports they need to double check and make sure that their passports are good for 6 months past our return date. So they need to be valid through Nov. 23, 2025.
- Schedule an appointment with a cooperating Post Office.
- It takes 10-12 weeks to receive
- Cost: \$130 for passport book with standard service - Check or Cashier's Check
- Cost: \$35 execution fee
- Cost: Some post offices will do the photo, although sometimes it's hard to get in.
Alternatively use Walgreens for passport photos. \$10.

****Take to the post office: (16 years old and older) - good for 10 years*

- The person getting the passport must be present
- DS-11 Application (that you filled out and printed off)
- 2 passport photos
- Driver's License
- Certified birth certificate (w/ raised seal)
