Scripture Reading (English) - Luke 23:13-25 (ESV) - Ryan

¹³ Pilate then called together the chief priests and the rulers and the people, ¹⁴ and said to them, "You brought me this man as one who was misleading the people. And after examining him before you, behold, I did not find this man guilty of any of your charges against him. ¹⁵ Neither did Herod, for he sent him back to us. Look, nothing deserving death has been done by him. ¹⁶ I will therefore punish and release him." ¹⁸ But they all cried out together, "Away with this man, and release to us Barabbas"— ¹⁹ a man who had been thrown into prison for an insurrection started in the city and for murder. ²⁰ Pilate addressed them once more, desiring to release Jesus, ²¹ but they kept shouting, "Crucify, crucify him!" ²² A third time he said to them, "Why? What evil has he done? I have found in him no guilt deserving death. I will therefore punish and release him." ²³ But they were urgent, demanding with loud cries that he should be crucified. And their voices prevailed. ²⁴ So Pilate decided that their demand should be granted. ²⁵ He released the man who had been thrown into prison for insurrection and murder, for whom they asked, but he delivered Jesus over to their will.

¹³ Pilato convocó a los principales sacerdotes, y a los gobernantes y al pueblo, ¹⁴ y les dijo: «Ustedes me han presentado a este hombre como a un perturbador del pueblo, pero lo he interrogado delante de ustedes, y no lo he hallado culpable de ninguno de los delitos de los que ustedes lo acusan. ¹⁵ Se lo envié a Herodes, y tampoco él lo ha hallado culpable. Por tanto, este hombre no ha hecho nada que merezca la muerte. ¹⁶ Voy a castigarlo, y después de eso lo dejaré libre.» ¹⁷ [Y en cada fiesta él tenía que poner en libertad a un preso.] ¹⁸ Pero toda la multitud gritaba al unísono: «¡Fuera con éste! ¡Déjanos libre a Barrabás!» ¹⁹ Barrabás había sido encarcelado por un levantamiento en la ciudad, y también por homicidio. ²⁰ Como Pilato quería soltar a Jesús, volvió a dirigirse al pueblo; ²¹ pero ellos seguían gritando: «¡Crucifícalo, crucifícalo!» ²² Por tercera vez Pilato les dijo: «¿Pues qué crimen ha cometido éste? ¡Yo no he hallado en él ningún delito que merezca la muerte! Voy a castigarlo, y luego lo dejaré libre.» ²³ Pero ellos seguían gritando, e insistían en que Jesús fuera crucificado. Al final, prevalecieron las voces de ellos y de los principales sacerdotes. ²⁴ La sentencia de Pilato fue que se hiciera lo que ellos pedían; ²⁵ puso en libertad a quien habían pedido, que había sido encarcelado por rebelión y homicidio, y puso a Jesús a la disposición de ellos.
