• Think carefully about what you've been asked

• Brainstorm ideas and [plan](#)

Make a list of the points you want to mention and decide what [grammar structures](#) and vocabulary (check out **Unit 1A** and **UNIT 10B** listening p. 168 and 203) are adequate to the topic and your level .

Think of both **a good start** (as Mónica Redondo says “*say hello and respond with style*”) and **a conclusion** for the dialogue.

Make notes with key words.

• Draft

Use your notes to perform your part; carefully listen to yourself and look out for possible mistakes. Remember pronunciation and fluency are important.

• Improve

Improve your first draft as much as you can and **rehearse, rehearse and rehearse**.
