Category	Points	Expectation
Paragraph One: UN History regarding Topic	5	Provides a clear and well-written historical overview from your country's perspective of the issue and any action the UN has previously taken. Includes a description of the issue, an outline of who is affected by it, and references to UN resolutions and other actions taken with regard to the issue.
Paragraph Two: Country History regarding Topic	5	Provides a clear and well written explanation of the role a country has played in addressing the issue. Includes information regarding domestic laws, policies, and actions, as well as international agreements the country has either supported or opposed.
Paragraph Three: Country Policy regarding Topic	6	Provides a clear and well-written explanation of the country's official policy. Should reference strategies and programs that are working and provide concrete proposals aimed at providing resolution or relief. Proposals should reference both multilateral approaches, regional and domestic solutions that Member States should adopt, and recommendations to UN bodies when relevant.
Formatting	4	Policy Statements is exactly one page in length, written in 12pt. Times New Roman font, and is single-spaced with one agenda item per policy statement. No grammatical or spelling errors. Country name, committee name, and agenda topic in successive lines, in all caps, in the upper left hand corner.

MUNFW Country Profile Scoring Rubric

Category	Points	Expectation
Formatting and Clarity	1	The profile is formatted correctly and easy to read with clear headings, organized sections, and no major errors in spelling or grammar. The profile is double-spaced and written in Times New Roman, 12pt. The profile is 4-6 pages in length.
Overview of the Country	2	The profile includes a comprehensive overview of the country that covers the official name, language, major religions, cities, population size and demographics, ethnic/cultural composition, colonial past, history, and an overview of allies/adversaries.
Politics	3	The profile provides detailed information on the country's politics, including the type of government, political structure, current leaders, military organization and expenditures, political culture, political stability, human rights record, and world rankings for political freedom and corruption.
Economics	3	The profile provides detailed information on the country's economy, including the type of economic system, GNP/GDP or PPP, major imports/exports and amounts, major trading partners/trading blocs, standard of living, infrastructure, major industries, amount/type of natural resources, and economic ranking.
Geography	3	The profile provides detailed information on the country's geography, including regions, neighbors, terrain, arable land, and information on whether the country is landlocked or coastal.
Current Events	3	The profile includes important recent events and uses news articles from the last 2-3 years to provide context and analysis.
UN History and Policy	5	The profile provides detailed information on the country's United Nations history and position, including the date admitted to the UN, financial contribution to the UN, country voting bloc, reputation and role within the UN, and overall strategy in the UN.

Category	Points	Expectation
Scope	5	Addresses all actors related to the issue and their roles (UN system, development agencies, humanitarian actors, Member States, civil service organizations, donors)
Content	5	Provides a clear and comprehensive list of proposals related to the issue and its elements
Header	1	Includes a proper heading with committee name, session number, and country name
Title	1	Has a clear and appropriate title and is addressed to the correct UN body
Preambular Clauses	3	Contains clear preambular clauses that justify the resolution's submission and passage
Operative Clauses	3	Includes clear operative clauses that denote the actions to be taken, using appropriate verbs and numbering
Grammar and Formatting	2	Follows the correct structure for preambular and operative clauses, with separate paragraphs and appropriate punctuation
