Executive Order 18:

Revoking Justice Department Directive 005

May 29, 2021

Whereas, on Thursday, May 06, 2021, Murpple, in his capacity as Attorney General of the State of Superior, issued Justice Department Directive 005;

Whereas, the language and intentions of the directive are not conducive to improving the quality of life or well-being of the people of Superior,

Whereas, the directive does little to improve, or generally alter, the proceedings and mechanics of Superior's justice department, thereby serving little-to-no purpose,

Whereas, although the Attorney General's motives are believed to be entirely benevolent and righteous, it is the official position of the Office of the Governor that J.005 does not accurately reflect the Attorney General's values;

Whereas, the prolonged existence of the directive would have the effect of undermining the authority and credibility of both the Superior Justice Department and the state government as a whole;

Whereas, to protect the integrity of our government, the Office of the Governor believes that executive action is required;

Now, therefore, I, Charles “Citizen” Barnes, Governor of the State of Superior, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and statutes of the State of Superior, do hereby proclaim as follows:

Section I: Revocation

1. Justice Department Directive 005, also titled “Touch The Sky, Feel The Earth,” is hereby revoked in its entirety.

Section II: Effective Date

1. This order shall go into effect immediately upon its filing in the State Register
