What is Happening this Week:

Guided Reading: Mrs. Winning

Every week we will complete a spelling packet with the new list of words. If your child misses class, or does not use their class time wisely, they will have makeup work in their red folder. Please have them complete it and return it to me for a grade. In class, we will continue to read to learn and read for fun, especially with our author study of Robert Munsch. <u>Please remember to be reading 20 minutes every night!</u>

Writing: Mrs. Bishop

This week, in Grammar, we will continue practicing what we have learned about the different types of sentences (Declarative, Interrogative, Imperative, Exclamatory, and Compound Sentences). This week in Writing we will be working on finishing up writing our Personal Narratives. Then we will begin diving into revising and adding details to make our writing better. We will also dive into working on improving our print letters in order to prepare for learning Cursive.

Language Arts/Phonics: Mrs. McLaughlin

This week we will practice decoding and encoding words beginning with I-blends, r-blends, and s-blends along with using these strategies in multisyllabic words. In language arts we will continue to read non-fiction texts based on animal habitats around the world with a focus on suffixes and using graphic organizers to understand on a deeper level.

Math: Mrs. Shaffer

This week we will be working relating addition with subtraction, adding within 20, and subtracting using mental strategies. Finding tools and strategies to make our adding and subtracting faster. We will have a test **Wednesday**, **September 10th**.

What do you do if you miss a day of school?
