- Any 100- and 200-level course (some limitations apply; see catalog) to reach 90 credits
- Faculty and academic advisor recommendations include:
 - [OSU Admission Requirement: - demonstrate second-language proficiency](#)
 - OSU will implement a new general education requirement called [Core Education](#) starting Summer 2025. It is possible to complete many at LCC within “electives”. They will transfer over as meeting OSU’s additional Core Requirements. Work with an academic advisor to determine which LCC courses meet various OSU Core Education requirements
 - Difference, Power and Oppression: Foundations
 - Students still **need an additional 12 credits at OSU** to be accepted into the pre-dietetics program. (If dual-enrolled, OSU credits can transfer to Lane to apply to the degree, except upper-division courses, such as NUTR 325). E-campus options that meet pre-dietetic requirements: NUTR 104, NUTR 325, NUTR 241, CH 331, and others

- Organic Chemistry: connect with academic advisors on organic chemistry options at LCC vs OSU
- CH 104 or 150 - if in need of an intro &/or refresher in chemistry
- COMM 296 - Communication in Healthcare Settings, ED 258 - Multicultural Education, HE 212 - Women's Health

In order to successfully graduate, students must:

- Earn a grade of a "C -" or better or Pass (P) in all courses
 - FN & NUTR courses must be completed with a letter grade of B- or higher, P is not accepted
 - BI, CH, PSY, & WR121Z courses must be completed with a letter grade of C- or higher, P is not accepted
- Earn all required credits required for the program
- Cumulative GPA must be at least 2.0
