

Here are 5 sample essays you may use when completing your reflection for Day 6 of the 12 Days of Innovation. You may use these in conjunction with the 6th Grade Scoring Guide linked on the website to try out our recommended best practices when providing feedback using AI.

Sample Response 1:

Chip and Xavier are similar because they both do fun stuff. Xavier teaches Abby how to surf, and Chip is good with animals like rabbits. They are cool and know things.

Sample Response 2:

Chip and Xavier are similar because they teach people. Chip teaches Luther about snakes, and Xavier teaches Abby how to surf. Both are good at what they do.

Sample Response 3:

Chip and Xavier are alike because they both teach others and are patient. Chip teaches Luther about the coral snake and waits for rabbits to come to eat grain. Xavier teaches Abby how to surf and gives her advice, showing that he is patient with her.

Sample Response 4:

Chip and Xavier are similar because they are both helpful and teach important lessons to others. Chip helps Luther by teaching him how to identify a dangerous snake using the rhyme, "Red by black, don't worry, Jack. Red by yellow, kill a fellow." Xavier teaches Abby how to surf and reassures her by saying, "I'll be here if you need me." This shows that both characters care about others and want to share their knowledge.

Both characters are also patient. Chip waits calmly for rabbits to come out, even when they are not showing up quickly. Xavier is patient with Abby as she learns how to paddle and balance on

the surfboard. Their actions demonstrate that they enjoy teaching and spending time with others.

Sample Response 5:

Chip and Xavier both show that they are caring and patient teachers. Chip helps Luther by explaining how to tell if a coral snake is venomous, using the rhyme, “Red by black, don’t worry, Jack. Red by yellow, kill a fellow.” This lesson could save Luther’s life. Xavier, in “A Wave of a Day,” teaches Abby how to surf. He tells her where to position her arms and how to paddle through the water. Both Chip and Xavier are patient while teaching. Chip waits for the rabbits to trust him and come out of hiding, even though it takes a long time. Similarly, Xavier is patient with Abby as she learns how to surf. He encourages her by saying, “I’ll be here if you need me,” making her feel supported.

Chip and Xavier both show confidence in others. Chip believes that more rabbits will come if they wait, which shows his trust in the process. Xavier believes in Abby’s ability to succeed, and he encourages her to try surfing on her own. Both characters care about others and take the time to share their knowledge in a way that builds trust and confidence.
