Artist Name: Jen Maramba

Tulay Araw is the name gifted to Jennifer Mae Maramba. Tulay Araw is a connector of many teachings, teachers and elders. She walks a path of light, love and healing while connecting to her ancestors, being guided by her teachers and learning with future leaders & healers.

Jen currently lives with her family in Tkaronto, a Mohawk word meaning "where trees stand in water" and is a city well known as Toronto. Jen and her family acknowledge that they walk upon the traditional territories of the Anishnawbe, Haudenosaunee, Huron-Wendat & Mississauga of the Credit Nation. Tkaronto is the home to many Indigenous Peoples residing under the Dish with One Spoon Wampum Treaty, that asserts all to peaceably share the land and its resources. Jen also acknowledges the Two Row Wampum and is a reminder of a Visayan (her mother's language) word "Dungan" which is described by her mother as two paths, side by side, moving in the same direction. A teaching that expresses that we walk in alignment with one another because we are interconnected yet, we must nurture our individual path.

Jen also holds Sacred Circles for healers and individuals who need a loving and safe place to hold Ritual and Ceremony for sacred intention, release, healing and Re-Membering. With the state of our realities, Jen has been called to assist and work with individuals who are called to the healer's path or to those who seek spiritual healing. Jen supports individuals with healing touch/energy work in connecting with guides, ancestors and past lives.

Jen is currently working with her guides and ancestors in journeying to heal one's past lives and ancestors so that one may live their current life fully with the teachings and guidance of the past. Jen is a Reiki Master and channels healing with and for the highest good!

Alexis Venerus is the Parkdale based curator of Grab-a-Slice, an experimental arts space inside Albany Pizza. Through Alexis Projects she shares her conversations with creatives, exploring the thought processes that take place around artistic action. She weaves together serendipitous connections amongst producers and unintentional audiences. Concepts imagined in these open discussions are brought to public exhibition, where she implements everyday objects and places as opportunities to show case artworks. This way the audience is offered familiarity as a framework for introspection and communal discourse. Her publication Insahyt Catalog 700-779 serves as a collection of references as to how a variety of minds separately brainstorm given themes. In June 2019, she exhibited the work of over 30 local and International artists whose pieces were covered in the first three volumes of the catalog. Venerus continues to fuse art with community through Grab-a-Slice as she curates work in a maximalist way with shows that offer catalyst to speculation and empathy in their variety of viewpoints.

As a poet, Lukayo competed at the Canadian Festival of Spoken Word twice as part of an Ottawa team and a Wild Card team. In 2011, they helped coach the Ottawa Youth Poetry Slam Team. Their poetry has been shouted out on national spoken word stages and whispered into local crowded classrooms. The Daily Xtra and 2B Magazine have first dibs to several of Lukayo's articles, while Breakwater Books accepted one of their essays in the anthology entitled Out Proud: Stories of Pride, Courage, and Social Justice.

Workshops are beloved by Lukayo, as this gives them an opportunity to listen as much as speak. Whether it's about gender diversity, healthier relationships, or anti-oppression– Lukayo's workshops offer an interactive experience tailored to a variety of learning styles and collective objectives. It is their lived experience and research that ground their teachings, while faith in collective impact informs their organizing and spiritual counselling.
