Important Safety Rules

Supervision and Responsibility

Operate Under Adult Supervision: A responsible adult must supervise the Bounce House/Slides/Inflatables at all times. No one should operate, supervise, or enter the Bounce House/Slides/Inflatables if under the influence of alcohol, drugs, or any other substance. No one should enter the Bounce House/Slides/Inflatables with any existing injury.

Personal Supervision: Supervision is required at all times, adhering to the guidelines on the number of riders. Only compatible age groups and sizes should play on the Bounce House/Slides/Inflatables at the same time. Extra caution and supervision are needed for children aged three (3) and under. Never allow older kids to bounce with children aged three (3) and under unless they are supervised.

Health and Safety

Individuals with Pre-existing Health Conditions: People with head, neck, back, or other muscular-skeletal injuries or disabilities, pregnant women, small infants, and others susceptible to injury from falls, bumps, or bouncing are not permitted on the unit at any time.

Remove Shoes, Glasses, and Jewelry: All persons must remove shoes, glasses, jewelry, etc., before playing in the Bounce House/Slides/Inflatables.

Prohibit Flips, Wrestling, and Extreme Horseplay: Flipping, wrestling, piling on riders, etc., may result in neck and back injuries and are not allowed.

No Silly String and Other Prohibited Items: No confetti, gum, food, drinks, sprays, or other sticky substances are allowed in or around the Bounce House/Slides/Inflatables. Contact with "Silly String" may cause irreparable damage, resulting in a replacement charge.

No Sharp Objects: Sharp objects are not allowed inside or around the Bounce House/Slides/Inflatables.

Behavior and Usage

Avoid Bouncing Against Sides or Doorway: Serious injuries may result from bouncing against the sides or near the doorway of the unit.

Do Not Jump on the Inflatable Step Area

Do Not Hang from the Netting: Keep toddlers from putting netting in their mouths and stay off the netting at all times.

No Climbing on the Unit or Netting: Climbing on the unit itself or the netting by persons inside or outside the Bounce House/Slides/Inflatables is prohibited. A repair fee will be imposed for damage from misuse.

Do Not Put Water Inside the Inflatable

· Jumping inside can be dangerous if the surface is slippery.

Emergency Procedures

If the Inflatable Begins to Deflate: Remove the children immediately. Check the motor, air intake screen, power outlet, and blower tubes for issues.

Keep Children Away from the Blower

Do Not Deflate Unless Rain is Imminent

In Case of Rain and Thunderstorms: Remove all persons from the Bounce House/Slides/Inflatables and turn off the motor. Dry the inside of the Bounce House/Slides/Inflatables with a soft clean towel after the storm to prevent slips.

Inclement Weather & Emergency: Do not use the Bounce House/Slides/Inflatables in windy conditions exceeding 20 mph, severe cold weather (below 40 degrees), or in a rainstorm. Children should exit immediately in an emergency, and the blower should be switched off.

Additional Safety Measures

Keep the Inflatable Unit Away from Swimming Pools

No Alterations or Attachments: No alterations or attachments to the Bounce House/Slides/Inflatables or area are allowed.

No Gathering at the Top of the Slide: To prevent collisions and ensure safety, refrain from congregating at the top of the slide. Only one person should be on the slide platform at a time.

Only One Person Sliding at a Time: For safety reasons, only one individual should slide down at any given time.

Limit on Dual Slides: To maintain stability and prevent overcrowding, limit the number of individuals on top of dual slides to a maximum of 4 at any given time.

Limit on Single Lane Slides: Single lane slides should only have a maximum of 2 individuals at any given time - one sliding down and one waiting at the bottom.

Turn Blower Off During Non-Use: During non-use, turn the blower off and allow the inflatable to deflate. Ensure the inflatable is empty before doing this. For multi-day rentals utilizing water, allow water to drain at the end of the day.
