MARCHING BAND & COLORGUARD

The Milford Marching Band is one of the premiere marching arts programs in the State of Ohio. Competing in multiple local events each year, as well as in Bands of America Regional & Grand National Competitions, the Milford Marching Band begins their season in late June/early July each year and concludes with near the end of the fall sports season. Students can be involved in marching band either as instrumentalists, or as a part of our nationally ranked colorguard program.
