Recently, a complaint has been raised to the Federal Elections Commission of the United States regarding a political image displayed in a recent issue of The Daily Statesman's newspaper outlet. The complaint statement alleges that Senator Whitey paid The Daily Statesman for this image to be displayed and that he is therefore legally responsible for it on grounds pursuant to 52 U.S. Code § 30109(a)(1). This has caused a significant amount of unrest across America as accusations have been thrown from both sides of the political spectrum. In addition, The Daily Statesman hereby pledges to henceforth disclose under all political advertisements and cartoons whether they have been designed by The Daily Statesman or whether they have been created and funded by an external source, in order to avoid any further confusion regarding this matter. In addition, The Daily Statesman wishes to thank the complainant, ModelAinin, for bringing this matter to our attention so that we can continue to serve the public interests to the best of our ability and uphold our pledge to Print News & Truth Since 1917! We will be offering to donate \$10,000 to the Federal Elections Commission to pay for the costs of any proceedings which have occurred as a result of these events.
