Warm Up: Health

In Chapter 8 of *Animal Farm*, the pigs think that Comrade Napoleon was dying after he drank too much whisky. A rumor goes around that Snowball tried to poison Napoleon. However, Napoleon eventually recovers and goes back to work.

Since mid-April, rumors have been going around about North Korea's Supreme Leader Kim Jong-un's health after he missed the celebrations marking the birthday of his grandfather and founder of North Korea, Kim Il-sung. Some rumors said that Kim Jong-un was in a "vegetative state." Other rumors said that he was "in grave danger" and doctors from China were sent to North Korea. However, Kim Jong-un has apparently recovered and visited a fertilizer factory.

This November, Americans will choose between two septuagenarian candidates, one of whom will become the oldest President of the United States. With several candidates in the Democratic Party as well as the sitting President over 70-years-old, there has been a greater scrutiny over the health of the candidates this election.

1. What should citizens know about their leader's health?
2. In the U.S., should presidential candidates release their medical records to voters?
3. How much (or little) does the presidential candidates' health factor into your decision to vote for either Trump or Biden?
