All Christian have the capacity to hear God

John 10:3-5

3 To him the doorkeeper opens, and the sheep hear his voice; and he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out.

4 And when he brings out his own sheep, he goes before them; and the sheep follow him, for they know his voice.

5 Yet they will by no means follow a stranger, but will flee from him, for they do not know the voice of strangers." NKJV

- You have to believe you can hear God.

Degrees or depth of hearing

Matt 13:8-9

8 But other fell into good ground, and brought forth fruit, some an hundredfold, some sixtyfold, some thirtyfold.

9 Who hath ears to hear, let him hear. KJV

- The more I seek then the more I find or hear.

Ps 46:10

10 Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth!NKJV

Ps 24:3-5

3 Who may ascend into the hill of the Lord? Or who may stand in His holy place?

4 He who has clean hands and a pure heart, Who has not lifted up his soul to an idol, Nor sworn deceitfully.

5 He shall receive blessing from the Lord, And righteousness from the God of his salvation.

NKJV

- Pure-cleanness of heart, sincere

Matt 5:8

8 Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God. KJV

The Unction from God

1 John 2:20

20 But ye have an unction from the Holy One, and ye know all things. KJV

Rom 8:16

16 The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: KJV

- God speaks to our spirit.

Rom 9:1

9:1 I say the truth in Christ, I lie not, my conscience also bearing me witness in the Holy Ghost,KJV

The Whisper

Some of the biggest things I needed to hear came in the whispers.

1 Kings 19:11-12

God's Revelation to Elijah 11 Then He said, "Go out, and stand on the mountain before the Lord." And behold, the Lord passed by, and a great and strong wind tore into the mountains and broke the rocks in pieces before the Lord, but the Lord was not in the wind; and after the wind an earthquake, but the Lord was not in the earthquake; 12 and after the earthquake a fire, but the Lord was not in the fire; and after the fire **a still small voice. NKJV**

- A low whisper- God can use the small voice to encourage us to turn toward Him to hear.
- Whisper- demamah- silence, stillness, or calmness. **In this atmosphere you will hear.**
- This same word is used to hush the storm with Jesus' words.
- To hear a whisper I must turn my attention toward the still small voice.
- Whispers you have to lean into on purpose to hear.
- Whisper is an intimate language. The secret place, "My hiding place."

The loudest voice must be "the whisper"

- GOD IS NOT GOING TO RUN AFTER YOU
- Must lean into to hear the whisper then you must disregard the other voices:
- White noise is all the frequencies. Many distractions.
- Science says we are interrupted every 3 minutes.
- God will speak the loudest when we are the quietest inside. In the midst of peace.

Devil will try to imitate God

2 Cor 11:14

14 And it is no wonder, for Satan himself masquerades as an angel of light; AMP

Don't let compassion cloud you

Rom 10:2

2 For I bear them record that they have a zeal of God, but not according to knowledge. KJV

- Your compassion can interfere with God's instructions.

Dull of hearing

Heb 5:11-12

¶ 11 Of whom we have many things to say, and hard to be uttered, seeing ye are dull of hearing.

12 For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which be the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat.

- When you hear but don't obey. Disobedience
- Lack of spiritual discipline. You start to let go of the little things.
- Lose your zeal and fervent for God. Red Flag

Lack of knowledge

Hos 4:6

6 My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I will also forget thy children. KJV

- Science says we are interrupted every 3 minutes.
- God will speak the loudest when we are the quietest. In the midst of peace.

Timing

Eccl 3:1

3 To every thing there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven:KJV

- Take what you hear from God and bring it back before Him.

Distractions

Prov 4:25-27

25 Let thine eyes look right on, and let thine eyelids look straight before thee.

26 Ponder the path of thy feet, and let all thy ways be established.

27 Turn not to the right hand nor to the left: remove thy foot from evil.KJV

The only problem you have is a hearing problem.

- Your answer is hearing God.
- Not with your outward ear but with your inward ear.
- His Voice is full of love, power, deliverance, and your answer to your every need.
- To hear in spiritual decibels beyond your hearing now you must attend with ears to hear.

Isa 30:21

21 Your ears shall hear a word behind you, saying, "This is the way, walk in it,"

Whenever you turn to the right hand or whenever you turn to the left.

NKJV

- God is always whispering to us in everyday and in every problem we face.
- His voice is behind us so we must turn from what we are doing to hear His voice.
- Inquire, ask for direction.

Pulling down “The Voices”

2 Cor 10:4-6

4 For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds,

5 casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ,

6 and being ready to punish all disobedience when your obedience is fulfilled. NKJV

- Obedience- is to hearken, listen.
- Hearing with the intent to obey.
- To hear God must get beyond the guilt, condemnation, blame, not” good enough”, no one cares, too old and all the voices that plague you daily.
- **If I don’t pull these thoughts down that is above God’s voice I will become deaf in areas of my life,**
