The KHEAA Dual Credit and Work Ready scholarships are now available for students to apply to get their two free courses for the year. Students have until October 1st to get this completed. Please note that the scholarship is not instantly applied to their account. Normally, the scholarship will go into their school account around the middle to the end of October.

A couple of notes:

- Students only get two dual credit scholarships for the whole school year.
- I have set up RAP workshops on Tuesday and Thursday for the next two weeks for students to sign up for to get help. They may also stop by during the day and sign up for help.
- Students will need to know their Social Security number to set up their accounts.

 Please make sure your social security number is correct because if you put in the wrong social, then you will not be able to apply and will have to call KHEAA.
- Students will not be able to make changes once they submit their preferences so, please make sure you have selected the correct school and semester. Below are examples of classes and how you would mark the scholarship. If you need any help with the scholarship, please let me know.
- On the link there is a customer service number for KHEAA if you have any problems. If you have already paid this semester and select the scholarship for the fall, then they will reimburse you. Normally, it takes a month or two to get back, but you should receive it in the form that you paid.
- When students make their account, I recommend using a personal email since students will lose their Boone County School's email after graduation.

EXAMPLES OF WHICH CLASSES QUALIFY FOR DUAL CREDIT SCHOLARSHIP

The Dual Credit scholarship covers all the core/general requirement courses. Common courses that fall under this scholarship:

ENG 101, MAT 150, HIS 108, CMST 101, HIS 114, etc.

To choose this scholarship, you will select WHERE you are taking the course and which semester. For example:

- If you are enrolled in GTWY ENG101 this semester, you would select FALL and GATEWAY.
- If you are in WRD110 through UK Next Gen, you select FALL and UK

WORK READY SCHOLARSHIPS

If the work-ready scholarship shows on your account, that means you are also eligible for that scholarship. Please make sure you do not mix up the dual credit and Work Ready on schools and semesters. Work Ready covers CTE courses (manufacturing, health care, business/IT, healthcare, construction, etc.), so if you are not sure what class you qualify for Work Ready then please let me know. This scholarship does not pay for core classes.

Examples for Work Ready Scholarship if taking these classes.

- NKU FLC 101- you would select the semester taking it and NKU.
 - Ryle students can take this course both in the fall and spring. If they are taking it now during 1st, they would select Fall.
- NKU JUS 101 you would select the semester taking it and NKU.
- NKU EDU 104/305 you would select fall NKU.
- GTW ACC 201 you would select semester you are taking class and Gateway.
- GTW BIO 137 you would select semester you are taking class and Gateway.
- TMU Courses:
 - o ACC 101/102
 - o BUA 105/155/115/311
 - o CIS 111/114/115/231/261
 - o CRJ 101
 - o EDU 101/201
 - o ELS 115
 - o LAW 105
 - o MIS 113
 - o NUR 104/103

<u>FIRE SCIENCE STUDENTS</u>: your classes will <u>only</u> qualify for the Work Ready scholarships. I know the dual credit link is there, but that scholarship can only be used if you are taking core classes, also.

Examples for Work Ready for Fire Science.

- FIR 101 you would select fall Gateway.
- FIR 102 you would select fall Gateway.
- FIR 103 you would select spring Gateway.
- FIR 104 you would select spring Gateway.
- FIR 106 you would select fall Gateway.

• FIR 107 - you would select fall Gateway.

FIR 230 – you would select spring Gateway. (If you are taking this class, I would suggest putting this as one your scholarships since it is a 6-credit hour class). I have not received the courses yet for those not taking this EMT course.

*2nd year students not taking the EMT course, I do not have the course codes yet for the two classes. You can still go ahead and select fall or spring.
