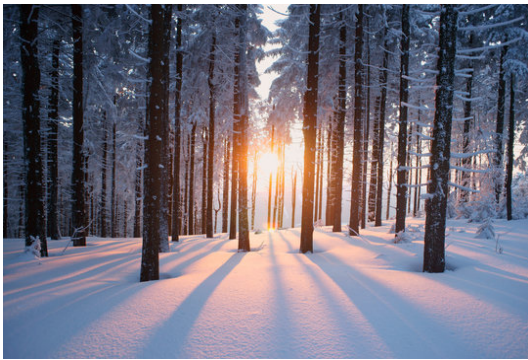

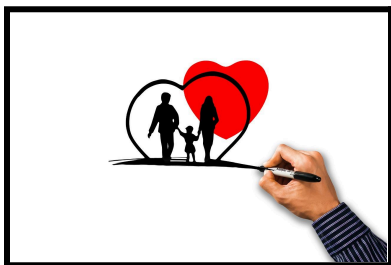
Milford Public Schools Community Connection Center is a bridge between families and available community services
