Additional notes:

Should the limit for outdoor events remain @ 50 on date of race, the event will be postponed / cancelled.

If the limit is changed to a higher number but not sufficient for our main race, we may be able to consider sending runners off in waves depending on the number allowed per wave. As this is a 2 Lap course no more than 3 waves could safely be accommodated.
