



2024 Career Motive-8 FAQ's

Q1. How many students will be attending the event?

- Approximately 1200 students will be attending Career Motive-8 (approximately 600 students for the morning session and approximately 600 students for the afternoon session)

Q2. What is the schedule for the day?

- The Naperville Yard is open at 7 AM (1607 Legacy Circle, Naperville IL 60563)
- Continental Breakfast, including coffee, will be provided for volunteers
- Morning Session: 8:45 - 11:00 a.m.
- Lunch Break: Boxed lunches will be provided for volunteers
- Afternoon Session: 11:45 - 2:00 p.m.
- Departure by 3 PM

Q3. What will be provided by Naperville 203 the day of the event?

- 8-foot rectangle table and 2 chairs
- Pathway signage
- Volunteer access tags
- Internet access (encourage you to bring your own hotspot if available)
- Limited electric outlets (looking into portable generators) Please bring your own extension cords and come with your devices fully charged.
- Refreshments including light breakfast and lunch
- A day full of student energy and excitement!

Q4. When can I set up my booth/table?

- Optional: Thursday, October 17, 2024 between 4:15 - 7:00 p.m.
- Friday, October 18, 2024 doors open starting at 7:00 a.m.

Q5. When should I arrive at the Naperville Yard on Friday October 18?

- Please check in and be ready by 8:15 AM on Friday morning

Q6. Do I need to stay for both sessions?

- Yes. Each session has different students attending and we want to ensure an equitable experience for both the morning and afternoon sessions.
- Due to the length of the event, we encourage multiple volunteers from your business/organization, if available, to attend.

Q7. Do I need to bring a tablecloth for my booth?

- Tablecloth will not be provided with your table. Please feel free to bring your own.



Q8. Can I bring signage?

- Yes, your branded material, signage, etc. is all welcomed and encouraged.

Q9. Can I pass out information and branded giveaways to the students?

- Yes. Students will have a bag to collect business information and handouts.
- Please be sure to have enough giveaways for both the morning and afternoon sessions.

Q10. Can we have food or candy at our booth?

- Please contact us to make arrangements if your hands-on activity involves food.
- Wrapped candy/small food items are okay. **No Nuts**
