Q1. How many students will be attending the event?

 Approximately 1200 students will be attending Career Motive-8 (approximately 600 students for the morning session and approximately 600 students for the afternoon session)

Q2. What is the schedule for the day?

- The Naperville Yard is open at 7 AM (1607 Legacy Circle, Naperville IL 60563)
- o Continental Breakfast, including coffee, will be provided for volunteers
- o Morning Session: 8:45 11:00 a.m.
- Lunch Break: Boxed lunches will be provided for volunteers
- o Afternoon Session: 11:45 2:00 p.m.
- Departure by 3 PM

Q3. What will be provided by Naperville 203 the day of the event?

- 8-foot rectangle table and 2 chairs
- Pathway signage
- Volunteer access tags
- Internet access (encourage you to bring your own hotspot if available)
- Limited electric outlets (looking into portable generators) Please bring your own extension cords and come with your devices fully charged.
- Refreshments including light breakfast and lunch
- A day full of student energy and excitement!

- o Friday, October 18, 2024 doors open starting at 7:00 a.m.

Q5. When should I arrive at the Naperville Yard on Friday October 18?

Please check in and be ready by 8:15 AM on Friday morning

Q6. Do I need to stay for both sessions?

- Yes. Each session has different students attending and we want to ensure an equitable experience for both the morning and afternoon sessions.
- Due to the length of the event, we encourage multiple volunteers from your business/organization, if available, to attend.
