Dear HCPS Families,

It is hard to believe that we have been in school for an entire nine weeks grading period. We appreciate all of the efforts, support, and engagement you have all contributed to the learning environment for our students.

On Wednesday, October 25, we will have an “Asynchronous Learning Day” for our students as teachers and parents meet for conferences. Conferences will be held between the hours of 8:00 am and 3:30 pm. Your child’s teacher may have reached out to you to set up a scheduled conference time or you may drop in to your child’s school during these hours. This Asynchronous Learning Day is a remote learning day at home for all of our students and is still considered an instructional day. Students will be expected to complete activities during this remote learning day in order to receive credit (*elementary students should turn in assignments the next day and secondary students should submit them online or turn them in the next day*). These food items will be sent home with students on Tuesday, October 24, 2023.

It is our full intention that our students can successfully complete assignments during the Asynchronous Learning Day at home. We are excited to also have this day for parents and teachers to discuss strengths, weaknesses, and any other needs during their scheduled parent/teacher conferences.
