#### Rails to Trails Program

- Extension of Delaware River Trail
- Currently terminates at Penn Treaty Park
- Conceptual plan to extend trail presented
- Gave overview of previous segments of trail opened between Casino and Penn Treaty Park and along Columbus/Delaware Aves
- Some of the work to be done will connect various segments of project
- Wherever possible, master plan is to put trail along river
- Medium term goal, hoping to make connections back to neighborhood
- Hoping to connect to Cumberland, Berks, Susquehanna, and Columbus Ave improvements
- Looking at ways to retro-fit I-95 infrastructure to compliment trails
- Have website where residents can weigh in on available or potential amenities
- Planning and engagement will wrap up in August
- Next steps are property acquisition and design
- In process for grants through HUD funding
- Pursuing funding for redesign on Cumberland St.

- Played highlight video from last year
- Looking for help planning or day of help for festival this year
- Looking for anyone who can contribute expertise on grants, sponsorships, etc.
- Hoping to bring more interesting stuff to neighborhood

#### New Business

- Resident to experienced a confrontation in the neighborhood around July 4<sup>th</sup>
  - Shared story of how people who were setting off fireworks inappropriately throughout night
  - When asked to quiet down – the group setting off the fireworks used racial stereotypes and racist language toward a person of color
  - When called, the police did not take the situation seriously
  - Question of how to bridge gap between groups of people in the neighborhood
  - Concern about how to keep our neighbors safe
  - Day after incident – car had been vandalized
  - Hoping to connect with community and overwhelm hatred with kindness in community
- Emerald St. Community Farm
  - Community run farm
  - Open to anyone in community
  - Open on Wednesdays from 5 to sundown
  - Received mini-grant to do landscaping and buy chairs for events at garden
  - ECFFarm on Instagram
  - Hosting movie nights
  - Leading up to Halloween event leading into Weirdo
