What is this course about?

At ASHS, our Māori Studies course allows ākonga to customise their learning journey. Students select Te Reo Standards aligned with their language proficiency and can also select Tikanga Unit Standards, as this course is also taught in partnership with Tikanga. Assessment sequences and specific standards are collaboratively decided with students to meet their credit goals.

Offered through Te Kura correspondence school, New Zealand's largest, our programme is supported by a Correspondence Coordinator who guides ākonga in navigating the Te Kura platform, submitting assignments, and receiving feedback from online teachers.
