

**Minutes of the Regular Meeting
of the Bevier C-4 Board of Education
March 17, 2025**

I. Preliminary Matters

- A. President Souther called the meeting to order.
- B. Approval/Amendment of agenda
Jonathan Basler moved and Ronald Shelmadine seconded the motion to approve the agenda for March 17, 2025. Approved 7-0.

II. Consent Agenda

- A. Ronald Shelmadine moved and Lindsey Howell seconded the motion to approve the consent agenda (minutes of the previous meeting on February 20, 2025, bills and staff salaries and request for executive session: Personnel. MO Statute 610.021 (3) (13) and Student. MO Statute 610.021 (8) Approved 7-0.

III. Old Business

- A. City of Bevier Watershed Project – Aaron McVicker met with the board. The board would like to meet with a representative of the City of Bevier about the project.
- B. Asbestos Removal Quotes for Music Room - Three quotes were received. The first quote was from GPAC in the amount of \$12,200 for Music Room and Hallway. The second quote was from Service Masters in the amount of \$8,225. The final quote was from Richard's Remediation in the amount of \$4,211 for the Music Room.

Ronald Shelmadine moved and Brenda Jennings seconded the motion to accept the quote from Richard's Remediation in the amount of \$4,211. Approved 7-0.

- C. Carpet Quotes for Music Room – Two quotes were received. The first quote was from Barry's Carpet for carpet without Cove Base. Materials \$4,000 and installation \$1,600. Total cost \$5,600. The second quote was from Kirksville Carpet One without Cove Base. Materials \$3,323.42 and installation \$1036.80. Total cost \$4,360.44. Custodians will install the Cove Base (Material \$80).

Jonathan Basler moved and Brenda Jennings seconded the motion to accept the quote from Kirksville Carpet One in the amount of \$4,360.44. Approved 7-0.

- D. Mass Messaging System Quotes – Four quotes were received for mass messaging system for the school. The first quote is from Textcaster for \$3,600 per year (texting only, goes up with more text volume). The Second quote is from Apptegy for \$,500 per year + \$5,000 onboarding (Much more options). The third quote was from Remind for \$2,500 per year (Flat rate. More options as far as groups) The final quote was from Parent Square for \$3,000 per year (Flat rate. Much more options) with a one-time \$500 Setup/Training fee.

Lisa Harrington moved and Brenda Jennings seconded the motion to accept the quote from Parent Square for Mass Messaging. Approved 7-0.

Band Room Risers – Brenda Jennings moved and Lisa Harrington seconded the motion to allow David Rhoads to dismantle and remove the risers in the music room. Approved 7-0.

B. Bevier/Callao Consolidation Petition: Cheyenne Mattingley updated the board.

Petition to Consolidate the Callao C-8 and Bevier C-4 School Districts

We the undersigned desire that the School Board of Bevier C-4 bring the matter of consolidation of the Callao C-8 and Bevier C-4 School Districts to the attention of the voters within that district, to be voted upon in favor by a yes vote or not in favor by a vote of no, upon the next available election.

The question shall be submitted in substantially the following form per Missouri Statute RSMo §162.233, to State:

Shall the Callao C-8 School District and the Bevier C-4 School District form a new district with a tax rate ceiling of \$3.99 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation? If this proposition is approved, the adjusted operating levy of the new school district is estimated to be \$3.99 (amount) per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.

A plat of the proposed new district shall be published and posted with the notices of election.

The results of the voting on the proposal in each district affected shall be certified to the state commissioner of education by the secretary of each board of education of each district or by such other person or body charged with conducting such elections, should the vote cast in each affected district be in favor of the proposal, the state commissioner shall declare the new district formed as of July first following the submission of the question.

Jonathan Basler moved and Brenda Jennings seconded the motion to approve placing the Bevier Petition upon the next available election ballot per Missouri Statute RSMo §162.233. Approved 7-0.
