Classroom	Connection Circle	This website has a neat question generator. You can even adjust the "depth" of the questions to be more light-hearted or more serious depending on the age group and familiarity.
	Scavenger Hunt	Create a scavenger hunt list and send students to breakout rooms. The students try to locate everything on the list with what they have available and bring it back to the camera. Great to do this outdoors to level the playing field!
	Show & Tell	Give your Zoom session a theme (like pets, favorite things, or costumes) and invite students to bring something to show the class.
