Chief Warrant Officer Four (Retired) (CW4 (Ret)) Constantine S. Green is a distinguished member of the United States Army, originally hailing from Kingston, Jamaica. CW4 (Ret) Green began his military career by enlisting in the Army on June 23, 1982, and entered active duty on June 15, 1983. Demonstrating exceptional leadership and dedication, he served as an enlisted Soldier for twelve years, attaining the rank of Sergeant First Class before his appointment as a Warrant Officer on December 12, 1995.

CW4 (Ret) Green is a graduate of numerous military education programs, including the Human Resource Management Course, Military Personnel Technician Warrant Officer Advance Course, Warrant Officer Basic Course, Warrant Officer Candidate Course, Adjutant General Advanced Non-Commissioned Officer Course, Adjutant General Officer Basic Non-Commissioned Officer Course, and the Primary Leadership Development Course, among others. His civilian education includes a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Administration from the University of Maryland University College, a Master of Arts Degree in Human Resource Management, and Master of Arts in Management and Leadership from Webster University.

His overseas assignments include tours in both Germany and Korea. As a Warrant Officer, CW4 (Ret) Green has served in several significant roles, including Military Personnel Technician and Detachment Commander, Delta Detachment, 24th Personnel Services Battalion, 3rd Infantry Division, Fort Benning, Georgia; Chief, Trainee Student Division, Fort Benning, Georgia; Deputy Adjutant General and Adjutant General/Chief, Military Personnel Division, Fort Meade, Maryland; Enlisted Strength Manager, G1, 2nd Infantry Division, Camp Red Cloud, Korea; Course Director/Class Advisor, Warrant Officer Advanced Course and Senior Instructor for the Human Resources Management Course, Adjutant General School, Fort Jackson, SC.

In August 2011, he was selected as the Senior Army Instructor and Department Chair for the Lewisville High School JROTC program, a role he held until his retirement in June 2018.
