Pathways Programs

- Pathways Internship Program
 - Year-round paid work experiences for current degree-seeking students. Interns may work during the summer, fall, spring, or year-round and are eligible for hire upon program completion.
- Pathways Recent Graduate Program
 - For graduates within two years of degree or certificate completion. Fellows are placed in a one-year career development program and may be eligible for hire upon completion of the program.
- Presidential Management Fellows Program
 - o leadership development program for advanced degree candidates.

Career Development Programs

- Agricultural Scholars
 - Engages graduate student scholars working in agricultural economics or related agricultural policy work with a year-long series of learning experiences.
- FAS Diversity Fellowship Program
 - provides a path for outstanding students, particularly those from minority groups, to pursue careers in the U.S. Foreign Service. The fellowship will provide funding and support for selected students to receive master's degrees in Agribusiness or Agricultural Economics at an accredited U.S. university of their choice. Fellows will participate in domestic and overseas internships with FAS.
