8th Grade Shadowing Guidelines

Students who would like to have shadowing experiences at prospective high schools should adhere to the following guidelines:

- 1. Shadowing is designed for those 8th grade students who are undecided or unsure about the high school they wish to attend.
- 2. Shadowing is limited to a maximum of **two** days in a school year.
- 3. Shadowing days will hopefully coincide with days during which St. Columban School is not in session. Consider teacher in-service days, parent/teacher conference days, or days when our school is not in session as the primary days for visitations.
- 4. Shadowing must be arranged between your family and the prospective high school. St. Columban School is not responsible for setting dates. Keep in mind that high schools will only take a limited number of visitors each day.
- 5. A shadowing form must be signed by the school visited and returned to St. Columban School upon returning to school.
- 6. The **two** shadowing days are excused absences if the shadowing form is turned in on the day the student returns to school.
- 7. Students should check Google Classroom for assignments. Class work missed, including tests, must be made up at the discretion of the teachers.
