## Conclusion

### Diagnosis:

- Patient was in a poor mood, and seemed somewhat fearful to be in Medbay due to past experiences with DCDs.

  - Patient was sick with both Anemia and Influenza.
    - ◆ Patient presented with less than ideal memory, potentially foggy from illness.
    - ◆ However, the patient maintained a good reaction time and excellent rhythm.
  - Patient has an average quality of sleep.
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### Treatment:

- Patient may benefit from therapy or an observation.
  - The patient was prescribed an influenza vaccination and vitamin B12 for the anomalies detected through blood work.
  - Patient was advised rest, hydration, isolation, and medication for the symptoms commonly associated with the flu. Patient was also advised to consume red meat or dark, leafy greens.
